

## Key Performance Indicators Set

### Unemployment rate

This is a classic market growth and health indicator; it is measured as the number of unemployed residents of seeking work divided by the total population eligible for work.

- MAIN REFERENCE: ISO 37120, CityKeys, STEEP/REPLICATE, UN SDG 8.5.2 detailed also for sex, age and disabilities
- DATA SOURCE: development department, chamber of commerce
- MEASUREMENT METHOD: employment or self-employment, but available for work, and seeking work (numerator) divided by the total labour force (denominator). The result shall be multiplied by 100 and expressed as a percentage (ISO/DIS 37120, 2013).
- PRIORITY: OPTIONAL
- Usefulness and user-friendliness: commonly used even if for small municipalities data are often referred to the region. It is reported also in UN SDG 8 – Sustainable Economic Growth
