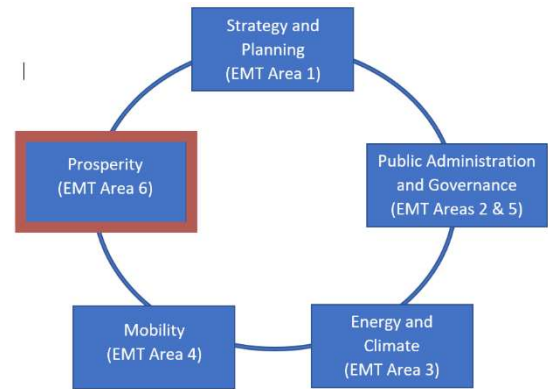


## Key Performance Indicators Set

### Population with density and trends (3 KPIs)

This indicates the size of the city and, if regularly updated, of its **demographic trends** which could have influence on other previous indicators.

To highlight the trends and to link them to other KPIs, also the % of population increase could be reported as well as the density (calculated automatically with the surface reported in the planning section)



- MAIN REFERENCE: CityKeys, CoM, ISO, EEA, Green Capital, STEEP/REPLICATE
- DATA SOURCE: registry office, national statistics
- MEASUREMENT METHOD: absolute number of inhabitants and per km<sup>2</sup>, % of population increase
- PRIORITY: GENERAL DATA
- Usefulness and user-friendliness: easy to find with trend and further details (age, gender...)
